Modifications / Clarifications relating to e-NIT for the supply of Pouch
Parshad (Ref: e-NIT No. CO/Pur/NE/661/2969 dated 03.12.2025)

The Competent Authority is hereby pleased to approve the following modifications/clarifications in the various provisions of eNIT No: CO/Pur/NE/661/2969 dated 03.12.2025 for the supply of Pouch Parshad (all other provisions of existing e-NIT shall remain unchanged): -

S. No.	Reference to clauses / provisions of the existing e-NIT	Approved Modification / Modified Provision / Clarification
1.	Period of Contract	The period of contract for supply with the successful bidder shall be 3 years with no provision for extension or price escalation.
2.	Clause 3(A)(iv)(c)	The Clause is hereby deleted ab-initio. (Consequent to deletion of this clause, the minimum required experience of prospective bidder shall be 5 years).
3.	Clause 3(A)(iv)(d)	In atleast three out of five financial years (ending 31st March, 2025), the bidder must have supplied / packed / sold dry fruits amounting to Rs. 5.00 crore or more as per the annual audited balance sheet and profit & loss account of the relevant period; duly authenticated by a Chartered Accountant (documentary evidence to be attached).
4.	Clause 14(xiv)	The water and electricity connection shall be facilitated by Shrine Board. The recurring cost in this regard shall lie in the scope of 'selected bidder'.
5.	Provisions mentioned under various clauses of the e-NIT relating to allotment of Shrine Board's built-up infrastructure.	The existing provisions of various sub-clauses of Clause 1 and other clauses of the e-NIT relating to allotment of Shrine Board's built-up infrastructure are hereby clarified / modified as under: i) That it shall not be optional but compulsory for the selected bidder to set up a complete processing and packaging plant in the built-up space provided by the Shrine Board. ii) Shrine Board shall provide suitable built-up space to the successful bidder ASAP. The T&C of allotment shall be mutually decided. However, there shall be no license fee or rent in lieu of allotted infrastructure. iii) Complete processing and packaging of ingredients including pasteurization shall have to be compulsorily done at the packaging plant set-up by the selected bidder in the allotted infrastructure only. No part of the processing and packaging process shall be allowed outside of the Plant set-up in the Board's infrastructure.

Consequent to the above modifications, the last date for bid submission is hereby extended till 02.01.2026 (upto 3PM).
